With reference to my letter of the 23rd March regarding the affairs of Messrs. Isaac J. Abdela & Mitchell, I have to acquaint you that in all the circumstances it has been decided not to press further the claim for the fees for the survey during construction of the Steamer "CORNISH MERCHANT" against Messrs. The Cornish Traders, Ltd., for your information I enclose herewith a copy of a further letter I have to-day addressed to the liquidator in the matter, in which you will observe that the fees outstanding in the case of the "CORNISH MERCHANT" have now been incorporated with those outstanding in the cases of the "AURORA", "CONISTON" and "WELL MEX 4", and an amended claim sent in accordingly.
