I beg to acquaint you that in accordance with the instructions contained in your letter of the 19th instant., I attended the Meeting of Creditors in connexion with the affairs of Messrs. Isaac J. Abdela & Mitchell, Lim., at Manchester yesterday. A statement of the affairs of the Company, a copy of which is enclosed, was read, and the Meeting decided to confirm the appointment of Mr. Joseph W. Shepherd as Liquidator, and to appoint an advisory Committee of three representatives of the largest creditors.

With regard to the second paragraph of your letter of the 21st instant I may say that it was inferred from the post-script of Mr. Shepherd's notice of the 10th February that he desired to be furnished as soon as practicable with a detailed statement of the account against the Company up to the date of liquidation.
