With reference to Liverpool First Entry Report No. 86169 on the steamer "CORNISH MERCHANT", I have to say that it is concluded that the thickness of the bottom angles to centre line keelson, upper and raised quarter deck stringer angles, and riveting of short bridge and forecastle side plating are as approved, but I shall be glad if you will kindly ascertain from the Surveyors and let me know whether this is so.

As regards the machinery, I shall be glad to know whether the safety valves are fitted with easing gear, to what pressure they were adjusted, and what is the distance between the boiler or uptakes and the bunkers or woodwork, as this information is not given on the report.
