Messrs. George Clark & Sons, Ltd, HULL, attend at their works on October 26th and November 1st, 1923, for the purpose of testing six lengths solid drawn copper pipes ordered by Messrs. Abdala & Mitchell, Ltd of Queensferry, and stated to be for their yard No. 463, the working pressure of the boiler being 130 lbs per square inch.

The pipes subjected to hydraulic test are as follows:-

The hydraulic tests, and bend tests from the materials were all satisfactory.

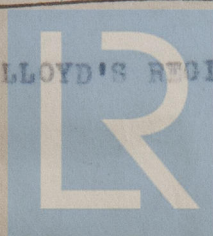
For identification the pipes are stamped with the test pressure and the initials - J.H.M.
