Dear Sirs,

With reference to Mr. Gwynne's report No.11235 on Messrs. Abdela & Mitchell's Engines No.1447 I have to point out that the Rules require 2 feed and 2 bilge pumps to be fitted on vessels with engines above 70 N.H.P. whereas it appears that only one feed pump and one bilge pump have been fitted.

In this case, however, the fitting of one feed and one bilge pump worked by the main engines will be approved, provided the Owners' consent be obtained and an independent power pump, as required by Section 4, Clauses 4 and 5, of the Rules, be fitted.
