

s.s. "FERNANDO POO".

This vessel was discovered at Bata, Spanish Guinea, by the insurgent cruiser "Ciudad de Mahon", and on attempting to escape was sunk by gunfire on the 15th October.

A copy of a letter, dated 20th October, received from Lloyd's Agents at Fernando Po, has been forwarded by Lloyd's to this office, giving full details of the casualty.

It was reported on the 23rd November that the vessel was lying in about 9 metres of water with all holds and engine room flooded. The fore end of bridge deck, with the bridge and most of the boat deck had been severely burned, but the gunshot holes were accessible for repairs at all tides. Salvage of the vessel was considered to be possible.
