Dear Mr. Mare,

With regard to the two accounts of £195-18-0 each owing by La Maquinista Terrestre y Maritima I have to inform you that I have discussed the matter with the Manager.

I was informed that there will be further delay before the accounts can be settled as certain certificates have to be drawn up in the special case of payment abroad for services rendered instead of the usual cases of payment for goods imported from abroad.

Payment of the accounts can be obtained in pesetas either here or in Bilbao without delay but I would suggest that it is preferable to live things as they are since we have the same difficulty in transferring sterling home.

I believe it takes about six to eight months usually to obtain the necessary permits to export capital from this country.
