the undersigned Surveyor to this Society, did at the request of their works on the 1st, 11th, 20th and 26th October 1934 and previous dates for the purpose of examining under construction and testing by hydraulic pressure on completion, four riveted steel air receivers with dished ends intended for the M/V "FERNANDO POO" which is being constructed at Bilbao by Messrs. Compañía Euskalduna de Construcción y Reparación de Buques.

The material has been tested by the Surveyors to Lloyd's Register; the scantlings are in accordance with the Society's Rules for a working pressure of 65 Kgs. per sq. cm. and the workmanship is good. These receivers have been tested in the presence of the undersigned by hydraulic pressure to 80 Kgs. per sq. cm. and found tight and sound in every respect at that pressure.

The working pressure of these receivers is not to exceed sixty five kilograms per sq. cm.
