for the purpose of ascertaining the nature and extent of the damage,
which is believed to have been sustained through the S.S. " NAHOON " striking
the vessel, whilst at Port Natal on the 30th April, 1942.

On examination the undersigned found the following damage and
recommendations for repairs as under:-

FOUND.

Starboard side, sheer strake No. 4
plate from aft, slightly indented.

RECOMMENDED.

To be faired in place.

It is recommended the above repair be carried out at the Owners
expense.
