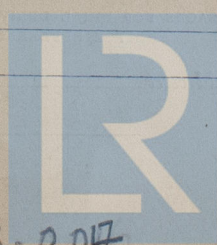

Priority secured to all Marconigrams in plain language, code or cypher.

* HALF RATE DEFERRED SERVICE.

Half Rate Deferred Marconigrams must bear the indication L.C.O. in address, which is counted and charged one word.

They must be written in plain language, and numbers, except in the address, must be written in words. language only, English or French, may be used.

* NIGHT AND WEEK-END SERVICE.

The rates quoted cover transmission by telegraph to destination in North America. Messages may be telegraphed from any Postal Telegraph Office, in which case the inland rate is payable in addition to the rates quoted. Telegrams must bear in the address the indication T L T for Night letters and T W T for Week-end letters. These indicators are counted and charged as one word each.

* NOTE—In addresses consisting of a name prefixed to a REGISTERED or ABBREVIATED ADDRESS, or where a telegraph is addressed to one person at the house of another, whose name is also given, the word "CHEZ" (care of), or some equivalent expression, must be inserted after the name of the addressee.

The sender can have his Marconigram repeated and checked by paying, in addition to the ordinary rate, one quarter of charge. The indication "T. C." must be inserted before the address and paid for as one word.

WIRELESS SERVICE TO SHIPS AT SEA.

Messages for transmission to ships at sea are accepted at any Marconi Telegraph Office and at all Post Office Telegraph Offices in the United Kingdom. For full particulars apply at the Company's Offices:—Marconi House, Strand, W.C.2, or No. 1a, Fenchurch Street, E.C.3.

CONDITIONS.

- 1.—The Marconi Company or any Telegraph Company or Government Telegraph Administration, by whom this Marconigram is or would be forwarded, may decline to forward such Marconigram although it has been received for that purpose; but in such case the amount paid for transmission will be refunded to the Sender at his request.
- 2.—Neither the Marconi Company nor any Telegraph Company or Government Telegraph Administration, by whom this Marconigram is or would be forwarded, shall be liable to make compensation for any loss, injury or damage arising from non-transmission or non-delivery of the Marconigram, or delay, or error, or omission in the transmission or delivery thereof, through whatever cause such non-transmission, non-delivery, delay, error, or omission shall have occurred, even though occasioned by the fault or default of such Company or Administration or any Officer or servant in their employ.
- 3.—The Marconi Company only receives this Marconigram for transmission in accordance with the provisions of the Regulations pursuant to the Telegraph Acts, 1863 to 1913, and the provisions of such Regulations shall be deemed to be binding not only between the Marconi Company, but between the Sender and any Telegraph Company or Government Telegraph Administration by whom the Marconigram is or would be forwarded in the ordinary course of the Telegraphic Service.
