This vessel previously with the American Bureau is desired to be classed with this Society and with this in view a Classification Survey S.S. No.3 has been held for the greater part.

The HULL Surveyors now report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated and minor repairs effected.

The vessel has now been transferred to the Managers, The British & Continental Shipping Agency Ltd. //
