The SWANSEA Surveyors report the vessel afloat and on account of damage through collision, the aftermost plate in 3rd strake below sheerstrake (p.s.) was found pierced.

Temporary repairs have been effected, and the Surveyors recommend this plate, together with the starboard boundary bar in way, be permanently repaired at the first convenient opportunity.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey, subject as recommended.
