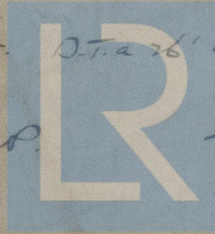
This vessel has been built with the Rule Number of Watertight Bulkheads.
