Port N°3 crank pin - 12-35 (Gen.Rpt N°14240)

Starboard flywheel shaft - 7-39 (Gen.Rpt N°15850)

Starboard Main Engine Injection Air Receivers - 5-36 (Gen.Rpt N°1442I)

Regarding the Port Nos.1,3 & 4 crank journals, it appears from our records that these have not been examined since 6-35.
