With reference to the freeboard assignment letter of the 7th instant, for the above vessel, we have to state that:-

- (1) The two 12" diameter ventilators to the 'tween decks have been efficiently supported.
- (2) The hatch beam to No. 6 hatch on the shelter deck should have been reported as 12"x.30". It is pointed out that the hatch is now only 9' long instead of 10' long as originally submitted.
- (3) The storm valves to the tonnage space are 6½x 3½.
