Dear Sirs,

It appears from a First Entry Report received -- from the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough that the S.S. "TOGSTON", built by the Furness Shipbuilding Company, has proceeded to your port for installation of machinery, and that to complete the survey the following remains to be done, viz:-

Tunnel to be completed and hose-tested;

Fidley covers, screen bulkheads, and skylights on casing tops to be fitted;

Windlass, winches, steam and hand steering gear to be tested;

Cargo escape hatches to be fitted;

Chain locker side and end plating to be stiffened at top edge;

Hatch webs, covers and tarpaulins to be examined.

I shall be glad if you will give the case the necessary attention, and forward a Report on Form B when the survey is completed, with a view to the classification of the vessel.
