Précis of particulars of Casualty When in tow this barge took a list and shortly after capsized and sank in ninety feet of water about nine miles from Vera Cruz on the 13th August, 1942.

Owing to lack of equipment it was believed that she would remain until the following spring and perhaps indefinitely.

Lloyd's Agent at Tampico stated in a letter dated the 7th June, 1943, that this barge is now a total loss.
