With reference to our Reports Nos. 71536-7-8 being forwarded to-day upon Standard Boilers manufactured by Messrs. R. & W. Hawthorn Leslie & Co. Ltd., St. Peters, we beg to advise you that the firm in question is desirous of receiving at an early date our account of fees due for the survey of these boilers; also for the survey of their boiler No. 8128 as per our Report No. 71439 forwarded on the 2nd December last.

We may point out that these boilers are intended for Standard Vessels but have not yet been fitted so that it is not possible to calculate fees upon the gross tonnage according to the usual practice.

In the circumstances we shall be glad to learn whether it is considered that a nominal fee might be fixed in each case, based upon the probable gross tonnage of the respective types of the vessels.
