"SAN ZEFERINO".

We refer to your letter N°821 dated 13th February and in reply we would confirm that the above vessel is still used as a Depot Ship. As regards the query you have received from the Secretary, Lloyd's Register, we give you hereunder text of a letter we have received which will enable you to answer same :-

"The vessel being out of class, it will be necessary to obtain a Seaworthy Certificate from a competent Authority before she can proceed to sea.

"So far as we know, the machinery and boilers are in good condition and capable of proceeding to sea without large repairs.

"As regards the hull, we should not expect to obtain a Seaworthy Certificate without doing a considerable amount of repairs, the extent of which can only be ascertained by making a special examination".
