## QUESTION.

With reference to my letter of the 31st December, 1937, a copy of which was sent to you, addressed to the Owners of the above named steamer, I shall be glad if you will kindly ascertain and let me know if this vessel is still in use as a depot ship and if she is still capable of proceeding to sea under her own power.

## ANSWER.

Date: February 28th, 1939.

On receipt of this memo I asked the local Representative regarding the latter part of the Question.

Not getting a reply I applied again to-day. I was informed that the question had been referred to the Shell Oil Co in London.

I am able to confirm that s.s. "San Zeferino" is still in use as a depot ship.

A special mooring device has been built on to the stem. This would require removal before recommissioning. Also I am credibly informed that to make this vessel capable of proceeding to sea under her own power "and be fit to carry petroleum in bulk" she would require a costly reconditioning.

On receipt of the Owners reply I will forward their remarks.
