I duly received Mr. Cox's letter of the 5th instant enclosing a copy of a letter addressed to you by the Ore Steamship Corporation, together with a copy of your reply thereto, regarding the proposal to omit two intermediate watertight bulkheads in the holds of the S.S. Nos. 165 & 166 proposed to be built by The Maryland Shipbuilding Co.
