I duly received Mr. Cox's letter of the 5th instant enclosing a copy of a letter addressed to you by the Ore Steamship Corporation, together with a copy of your reply thereto, regarding the proposal to omit two intermediate watertight bulkheads in the holds of the S.S. Nos. 185 & 186 proposed to be built by The Maryland Shipbuilding Co.

It is observed that the Owners desire the bulkheads to be indicated on the approved plans of these vessels, and the arrangements approved by the Surveyors are duly noted. When the vessels are classed, a notation will be made in the Register Book as follows:- "2 Intermediate bulkheads dispensed with; 5 R.H. only".
