To complete the work the parts of the bulkhead in way of the D.G. cables require to be dealt with and scupper pipes fitted.

A notation will not require to be inserted in the Register Book in this case, in view of the "Tonnage Opening Closed (W.E)". Some minor alterations and repairs have been carried out.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed subject as above.
