Dear Sir,

I herewith enclose for the consideration of the Committee a letter received from Messrs. Steven & Struthers, respecting a Bronze Propeller which they have made to the order of Messrs. David Rowan & Co.Ld., for their Engines No.1016 to be fitted in Messrs. Chas. Connell & Co's Vessel No. 424.

The propeller has been examined, so far as could be seen it is sound and in my opinion it is fit for service. The tensile strength, however, is below that prescribed by the Society's Rules viz:- 27.4 tons with an elongation of 41%. A second test piece broke at 26.4 tons and 18% elongation, this sample, however, included a flaw.
