The SAINT JOHN'S N.B. Surveyor reports (8,42) the vessel afloat and repairs effected to boiler casing etc. where wasted or fractured.

The foundation bar as above, has been temporarily reinforced with flat iron welded in place and the Surveyor recommends permanent repairs at the first opportunity. (1)

The Shelter deck plating inside deckhouse, (p.s) as above, wasted and holed has been temporarily repaired with doublings and fore and afters, under the deck and the Surveyor recommends permanent repairs at the first opportunity. (2)

The HULL Surveyors report (9,42) the vessel afloat and repairs effected to windlass and hawse pipes.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed subject as above.
