

Subject to indented shell plating (p & s) and to indented bottom plating and No.5 plate from in 3rd strake below shear (p.s.) and indented aftermost stern plate and to permanent repairs to indented shell plates No.4 in 1st, 2nd and 3rd strakes below shear and frame in way (s.s.f) being dealt with at the Owners' convenience, to permanent repairs to indented shell plates J.10 & 11, deck plating and framing and to plating and framing in No.2 hold (p.s.), to repairs to stem, stem plating and indented plating (s.s.) at the first opportunity and to rudder plate, E.W. and reinforced 3.42 and E.W. 8.42, being specially examined at the next dry docking.
