pumps, 22½" x 15" x 24" intended for
the R.F.A. "Francol" (Earle's C.B. Co.)

The steam cylinders & pump chambers
have been tested by hydraulic pressure
to 300 lbs per sq in.

The pumps were tried under steam
for a short period at the makers
and worked well; the water discharged
being at the rate of 200 tons per hour.
The pumps were afterwards opened
out & examined.
