

Replying to your letter of December
 in reference to the water ballast tanks
 steamer "Vauplos" of "War Drives"
 being made, whilst under construction, suitable
 for the carriage of oil fuel, I beg to state
 that I had an interview with Mr. Fowling
 on the matter, in which I stated, that to the
 best of my recollection, both the above
 vessel and her sister ship the "War Sniper"


