delivered and placed on board.

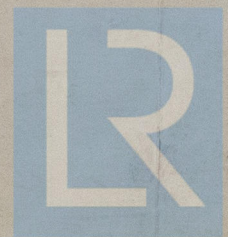
We are informed that the ballast tanks have been made suitable
