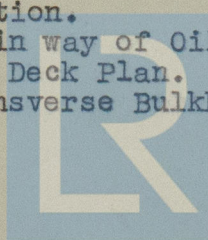
Please note that it is proposed to build a Single Screw Motor Tanker under the above number for the Anglo-Saxon Petroleum Co. Ltd.

This vessel will be similar in all respects to Nos. 1008 and 1009 building at our Works at Govan, except for some slight alteration in the Crew's Accommodation, and, it has, therefore, been decided to build the vessel to the plans prepared by our Govan Works.
