I have to acknowledge receipt of your cablegram relative to the vessel "EBONOL" which read as follows :-

" EBONOL ADMIRALTY STATE ONLY INTEND USE SHIP AS STORAGE HULK WITH OCCASIONAL SHORT TRIPS OUTSIDE HARBOUR STOP COMMITTEE THEREFORE AGREEABLE GENERAL EXAMINATION INCLUDING DOCKING BOILER AND SCREWSHAFT SURVEYS BEING HELD SEE MY LETTER TO ANDERSON TWELFTH DECEMBER = COMMITTEE "

It appears that Mr. Anderson had informed the Admiralty Representative at H.M. Naval Base, Singapore, of the Society's requirements for the re-classification of this vessel. In view of the fact that it was proposed to restrict the vessel's service, the Naval Store Officer asked me by telephone whether these requirements could be reduced in any way and I suggested to him that the Admiralty in London be asked to approach you direct.

When the vessel comes under survey I shall be guided by the instructions contained in your cablegram.
