A Representative of the Naval Stores Department has telephoned that they are informed by the Singapore Agents that a Second Special Survey No. 3 is desired by you in this case

It is the Admiralty's intention only to use the ship as a storage hulk but with occasional short trips outside the harbour, and it is desired that a less extensive survey shall be held bearing in mind the proposed restricted service.

In view of his request I have cabled to you, as per copy herewith, and trust that you will be able to trace my letter to Mr. Anderson on the 12th December last from which it will be seen that should it be impracticable to carry out a full Special Survey the Committee would not object to a General Examination being held in accordance with Circular 1772 including drydocking, Boiler and Screwshaft Surveys.

This decision is in accordance with other similar cases where vessels are to be employed for restricted service.
