



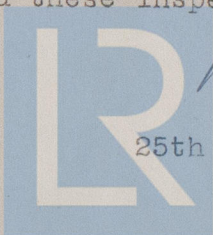

Mr. Shearer has telephoned from Glasgow that this vessel is now at Adelaide. She is likely to be trading in the Persian Gulf for some time and he would like to take advantage of the present opportunity to hold the requisite Load Line Renewal Survey.

With regard to the General Examination which is due in August, he would also like any parts of the vessel seen to be credited towards such an examination but, as he understands Adelaide is a difficult port for repair work, he wants repairs to be kept to a minimum.

He suggests that it will suit the Owners' convenience best if we will cable to Mr. McCowan instructing him to arrange for one of the Society's Exclusive Surveyors to proceed to Adelaide to hold these inspections.
