I enclose a report which has now come to hand from the Society's Surveyor at Jacksonville on the motorship "CAPE CLEAR", together with correspondence which has recently taken place with Mr. Shearer. You will observe that the survey carried out was confined to an examination of the bottom and rudder in drydock, the inspection of the screwshaft and the examination of the hatchways, ventilator coamings, deck and general equipment.

In the circumstances I shall be glad if you will advise Mr. Shearer accordingly, and I may say that it is concluded a further letter in regard to the General Examination and Load Line Renewal Survey may be anticipated from him in due course, in view of the expiration of the Load Line Certificate on the 20th July next.
