(Steam pressure 5 - 10 lb. per square inch) made to the order of Messrs. D. Rowan & Co., Ltd., and intended for their Engine No. 1020.

The cast iron shell with end covers were examined under a hydraulic pressure of 30 lb. per square inch, and found sound and tight.


