I return herewith one set of the plans, forwarded with your letter of the 19th instant, of fuel oil tanks proposed by Messrs. David Rowan & Co. Ltd., Engines Nos. 1020, for Messrs. Lithgows Ltd., Yard No. 906, and I have to inform you that these plans will be approved provided the welding be to the satisfaction of the Surveyors, and the tanks be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

I have to point out that in the case of the Boiler Fuel Oil Settling Tanks, and Purified Fuel Oil Tanks, the sectional area of the combined air and overflow pipe should be not less than the total sectional area of the combined filling pipes.
