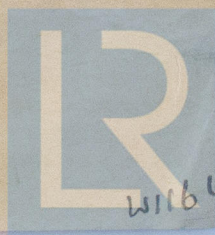
With reference to Mr. Roberts' report dated 10,42, on the fitting of shelter 'tween deck bulkheads in the case of the motorship "DUNEDIN STAR", think it well to refer you to the Ministry's circular 52376/42, paragraphs four and five. I shall be glad if you will ascertain from the Surveyors and let me know whether the number and arrangement of the shelter 'tween deck bulkheads now fitted, and those existing in the fore body of the vessel have been accepted by the Ministry.

At the same time a sketch should be forwarded indicating the positions of the existing bulkheads, and the Surveyors should state whether they are satisfied as to their scantlings and the closing arrangements of any openings in the same.
