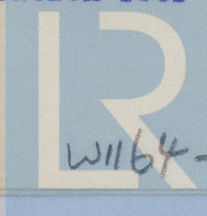
Dear Sir,

In your letter of the 1st January enclosing London reports (Rpt 7B) Nos. 668, 69.70 in respect of the electric generators built by the General Electric Co.Ltd., for Messrs.Cammell Laird & Co. Yard No.1009, s.s."DUNEDIN STAR" it is stated that the fee chargeable, viz:- £7:7:0: and expenses £3:18:0: should be included in our account on completion of the vessel and the amounts placed to the credit of the London Office.

Accordingly this amount was charged to Messrs.Cammell Laird & Co., in addition to the scale fee of £70:10:0: for survey of Electrical Installation, but the Builders object to this additional fee, although agreeable to the payment of the expenses incurred.

In the circumstances I shall be pleased to learn if it is considered that the scale fee of £70:10:0: should include the £7:7:0: due to the London account or if this amount and expenses can be recovered from the Makers of the Generators.

The payment of the classification fees for this

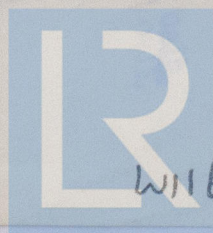
