Kincaid & Co., Ltd., Engineers & Boilermakers, Greenock, survey during construction and when completed, at their Arthur Street Works on the 18th February, 1930, and subsequent dates, one Steel Caustic Soda Tank intended for the T.S. Motor Vessel "ATHELKNIGHT" of Liverpool, (Engine No. K.50).

This tank was tested at each side of the division plate to 200 lb. per square inch, the tank afterwards as a whole tested to 200 lb. per square inch, hydraulic pressure, and found satisfactory and tight at this pressure.

Working pressure should not exceed one hundred pounds per square inch.
