Action has been deferred for permanent repairs to damage through enemy action.

The NEWCASTLE Surveyors report the vessel placed in dry dock, bottom coated and on account of damage through enemy action, extensive renewals or repairs effected to shell plating, framing, bulkheads etc.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed with record of survey 7,41.
