SURVEY REPORT.

B.O.T. No. 58350, certify that at the request of Messrs. Sierra Leone
Coaling Company, Limited, Lloyd's Agents at Freetown, Sierra Leone,
I attended on board the

s.s. "CORABELLA"

of London 5682/3373 Registered Tons, Captain W.A. Leggett, Master,
as she lay afloat in the Harbour of Freetown, Sierra Leone, on the
8th. day of October, 1942, for the purpose of examining repairs carried
out by the vessel's Engineers whilst at sea, repair consisting of
renewal of studs, holding down the rudder stock gland in the transom,
and securing gland to ship sides by the means of bottle screws.

On examination this repair appears secure, and the vessel may proceed
on her voyage to the next port, where the gland should be re-examined.
