I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 3rd ultimo respecting the steamer "CORABELLA", the contents of which are noted and for which I have to thank you.

With regard thereto, I may say that as the result of correspondence which took place last month with Messrs. John Kilgour Ltd. the Committee agreed to the General Examination for maintenance of class being postponed until the vessel's return to the United Kingdom and to the Screwshaft Survey being carried out on the occasion of the next drydocking. According to a return received from the Society's Surveyors at Middlesbrough dated the 4th instant the vessel was then under survey at that port for General Examination but the report on the case has not yet come to hand.

I have to add that due note has been taken of your request in regard to future correspondence which will be dealt with as you suggest.
