Messrs. Lithgows Ltd., "Y" Type Admiralty Cargo Vessels.

With reference to your letter of the 21st instant regarding the additional strengthening required on the above vessels, I have to state that a Memorandum has been prepared by the C.S.S. Department a copy of which, it is understood, has been forwarded to you giving the increases to the scantlings of the tween deck hatch side increases, the hatch end beams and centre line bulkhead stiffeners etc., required to comply with the full requirements of Circular M.S. 972/42. The increased thicknesses required to the upper deck are as stated in paragraph one of the above circular. In these circumstances the plans forwarded by you are being returned herewith.

As stated in the covering letter to the above memorandum, if it is desired to adopt equivalent arrangements plans should be submitted.
