Dear Sirs,

E. I duly received your letter of the 30th ultimo, with enclosed plans advised therein, showing arrangement of steam pipes in the Boiler Room of the s.s. "HOPETON" proposed by Messrs. Swan, Hunter & Wigham Richardson, for the conversion from saturated steam to superheated steam, and I have to inform you that these plans will be approved for a working pressure of 200 lb. per sq. inch, provided the drainage arrangements of all the steam pipes be to your satisfaction, all fittings in contact with superheated steam be made of cast steel or other approved material and the whole of the work be carried out under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

I return herewith the three plans which accompanied your letter.
