Dear Mr. Warlow,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 10th instant, regarding the case of the s.s. "CITY OF STOCKHOLM".

It has always been an inflexible rule of the Society that fees must be paid before records of survey are made in the Register Book, and we are sorry that it is impossible for us to make an exception in the present case. Otherwise the Society would be put in a false position as regards other Builders with whom similar questions arise from time to time.

In the circumstances particulars of the "CITY OF STOCKHOLM" will be included in the posting of the Register Book which commences on Monday next with a record of 100A1 - Class Contemplated, and as soon as we have advice from you of the payment of the fees, the words "Class Contemplated" will be deleted, and the full classification records made.

It is very unfortunate that owing to the omission of the Surveyor concerned the steamer should have been at sea for two or three weeks, without any records appearing in the Register Book about her.
