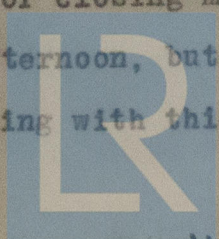
Dear Mr. Warlow,

I am in receipt of your letter of the 8th instant, and carefully note what you say regarding the case of the S.S. "CITY OF STOCKHOLM".

We have received the first entry reports today, and in the ordinary course we should be able to get full particulars of the steamer recorded in the posting which begins on Monday morning next, but we observe that unfortunately the fees are still unpaid. Unless, therefore, we defer making a record of the vessel in the Supplement, although the steamer has been at sea for some time, we shall be obliged to enter the vessel with the record "Class Contemplated" which is obviously undesirable for everybody concerned.

In the circumstances it occurs to me to suggest that it would be well for you to get into touch with the Builders first thing tomorrow morning, with a view to obtaining prompt payment of the fees, so that we shall be free to record the steamer in the Supplement with full particulars of class.

The scheduled time for closing matter for the next posting is four o'clock tomorrow afternoon, but in order to give some little margin of time for dealing with this case, I have
