I am enclosing herewith copy of a letter addressed to the Sun Shipbuilding and Dry Dock Co., Chester, Pa., having reference to the approval of plans of Midship Section and Typical Oiltight Bulkhead in the case of their Hulls Nos. 208, 209 and 210, now being constructed to the order of the Petroleum Shipping Company.

For your information I may add that Preliminary plans of these vessels have already been approved and copies were forwarded to you on the 13th March last and acknowledged in your letter of the 4th April last. Since that date the length of the vessels has been increased from 487.5' to 500' and the scantlings suitably increased.
