I duly received your letter of the 13th ultimo enclosing a copy of one addressed to Messrs. Sir Joseph W. Isherwood & Co.Ltd., New York, regarding the approval of preliminary plans of midship section and typical transverse bulkheads of three Tankers, 487.5 feet in length, proposed to be built by the Sun Shipbuilding & Dry Dock Co., together with a copy of each of the plans in question, and I have to thank you for your attention in the matter.

The scantlings and arrangements indicated on the plans have been examined generally in this Office, and, assuming that the openings in the deck do not exceed one hatch 48" in width each side of the centre line this hatch being cut in the thin strakes of deck plating, appear to be in order.
