Isherwood & Co. has incorporated a new feature in respect of the H bars to the transverse bulkheads; also that the longitudinal and transverse bulkheads are of corrugated type.

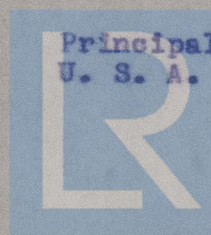
