We acknowledge with thanks your letter dated 23rd July with copy of Report of Survey held at Glasgow in February last.

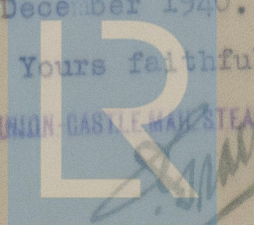
